

Dodge Neon | 1994-1998 Car Radio Removal



STEP 1:

The plastic dash panel that surrounds the radio and air conditioner controls must be removed before you can remove the radio. This plastic dash panel simply unsnaps from the dash without using any tools. Pull gently on any corner of the dash panel and it will unsnap from the dash. Set it aside, out of the way.



STEP 2:

The radio is secured to the dash with 2 bolts. Locate and remove two (2) 10mm bolts that secure the radio.



STEP 3:

Once the 2 bolts are removed, pull the radio out of the dash. Unplug the antenna cable plugged into the rear of the radio. Unplug 1 gray and 1 black connector snapped into the rear of the radio. Unplug the small plastic connector with one wire snapped into the rear of the radio. The radio is now free to be completely removed from the dash.
