

Nissan Pick Up Trucks | 1995-1997 Car Radio Removal



STEP 1:

Locate and remove two (2) Phillips screws located on the underside of the hangover of the dash panel between the air conditioner controls and the air conditioner vents.



STEP 2:

Once the 2 screws have been removed, the plastic dash panel surrounding the radio can be removed. With your hands, grab and pull the top of the dash panel near the air conditioner vents. Once the top is unsnapped, continue until the bottom of the dash below the radio is unsnapped. Unplug the connectors attached to the rear of the cigarette lighter and hazard switch.



STEP 3:

Once the plastic dash panel has been completely unsnapped from the dash, you will notice the radio and pocket below the radio. The radio and pocket are attached together as one unit by metal brackets secured to each side. To remove the radio/pocket assembly, you will have to locate and remove four (4) Phillips screws that secure the metal brackets to the dash.



STEP 4:

Pull the radio out of the dash, unplug the black cable plugged into the rear of the radio. Unplug the white wire harness connector(s) plugged into the rear of the radio.

Pull the radio completely out of the dash.
