

Chevy Blazer | 2000 Car Radio Removal



STEP 1:

To remove the radio, the entire dash panel surrounding the radio and instrument display must be removed. No tools are needed to remove the dash panel, only your hands.

The best place to start is left of the steering wheel above the air conditioner vent.



STEP 2:

With your hands, firmly pull the upper left corner of the dash panel. You will hear the dash begin to unsnap from the dash.



STEP 3:

When the left side of the dash has been unsnapped, pull the upper right corner of the dash near the radio to unsnap the rest of the dash panel.



STEP 4:

Completely remove the dash panel from the main dash body. Set the dash panel out of the way. The radio should now be visible.

STEP 5:

The radio is secured to the dash with a single snap on each side of the radio. You should see a pull down lever or arm on each side of the radio. Pushing the lever/arm down will free the clips and the radio can be pulled from the dash.



STEP 6:

When the radio is pulled from the dash, unplug the antenna cable from the rear of the radio. Unplug the plastic wire harness connector plugged into the rear of the radio.

The radio can now be removed from the dash.
