

Dodge Ram 1500/2500/3500 | 1997-2000 Car Radio Removal



STEP 1:

To remove the radio, the entire plastic dash panel surrounding the radio and dash instruments must be removed. No tools are needed to remove the panel, it simply unsnaps from the main body of the dash. With your hands, starting in either the upper right or upper left corner, firmly pull the plastic dash panel until it begins to unsnap from the main body of the dash. Once both sides of the plastic dash panel have been unsnapped, fold the steering wheel to its lowest position and pull the plastic dash panel away from the dash. Set it aside out of the way.



STEP 2:

Once the plastic dash panel has been removed, the radio should be visible. The radio is secured to the dash with two (2) bolts. Locate and remove two (2) 10mm bolts securing the radio.

When both bolts have been removed, pull the radio from the dash. Unplug the black cable attached to the rear of the radio. Unplug one (1) gray and one (1) black connector attached to the rear of the radio. There will also be a single wire with a plastic connector on the end of the wire which is attached to the rear of the radio. Unplug this connector. The radio can now be completely removed from the dash.
