

Ford F-150 | 1987-1991 Car Radio Removal



STEP 1:

The plastic dash panel surrounding the radio unsnaps from the dash. Open the ashtray so it does not block the plastic dash panel from removing. With your hands, pull the top of the plastic dash panel until it unsnaps from the dash.

Once removed, the radio and screws which secure the radio should be visible.



STEP 2:

The radio is held in on each side of the radio with 2 screws. Depending upon the year of your vehicle, the screws may be either phillips screws, or 7 mm bolt screws.

Remove all 4 screws. Pull the radio out of the dash. Unplug the black cable plugged into the rear of the radio. Unplug 2 plastic wire harness connectors plugged into the rear of the radio.
