

Nissan 240 | 1995-1998 Car Radio Removal



NOTE:

The radio is secured to the entire radio-pocket assembly as one unit, including the plastic panel surrounding the radio. **DO NOT** pull the plastic panel away from the radio or you will break the plastic panel. The radio and plastic panel must be removed together, as one unit.

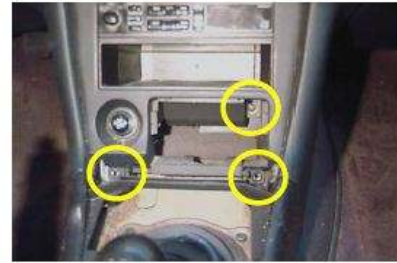


STEP 1:

With your hands, unsnap the plastic dash panel that surrounds the gear shift.

For automatics: this panel will pull completely away.

For stick shifts: the protective leather boot will keep the panel from pulling completely away. Just move twist it out of the way.



STEP 2:

At the very bottom of the plastic dash panel that surrounds the radio (below the ashtray and cigarette lighter) are (2) Phillips screws hidden by the plastic panel that surrounds the gear shift. Locate and remove both screws. Pull out the ashtray. Locate and remove (1) Phillips screw hidden behind the ashtray.



STEP 3:

The top of the plastic dash panel surrounding the radio has a snap bracket that is hidden underneath the air conditioner vent panel located above the radio. Before the radio assembly can be removed, this air vent panel assembly must be removed. Grab the bottom of the air vent panel and pull firmly. The air vent panel will unsnap and pull away. Unplug the wire harness connectors plugged into the rear of the air vent panel assembly.



STEP 4:

Hidden behind the air vent panel assembly just removed are (2) Phillips screws that secure the top of radio assembly into the dash. Remove both screws.



STEP 5:

All screws that secure the radio assembly have been removed. **REMEMBER**, the radio is attached as one unit to the plastic panel that surrounds the radio.

Grab the radio/panel assembly and pull it out of the dash. Unplug the connectors attached to the rear of the cigarette lighter.



STEP 6:

Unplug the black cable plugged into the rear of the radio. Unplug (2) white plastic wire harness connectors snapped into the rear of the radio. Pull the entire radio assembly out of the dash and move to the following pages to see how to remove the original radio and mount the new radio.
