Toyota Camry | 1992-1995 Car Radio Removal







STEP 1:

Insert the tip of a small flat head screwdriver between the lower right corner of the 'U' shaped plastic dash panel surrounding the radio and the softer main dash assembly. Gently pry the 'U' shaped plastic dash panel until the lower corner unsnaps. With your hands, continue to unsnap the plastic panel on the left side. Once the bottom has been freed, pull the plastic panel until the 2 top sections have separated from the dash. The sides of the radio should now be visible.

STEP 2:

The 'U' shaped plastic panel can be left hanging off to the side by the cigarette lighter wiring. Locate and remove four (4) 8 mm bolts securing the radio (2 on each side of the radio). The gear shift will need to be moved out of PARK for the radio to be removed. Pull the radio out of the dash. Unplug the black cable plugged into the rear of the radio. Unplug either 1 or 2 blue plastic connectors plugged into the rear of the radio.
